Goals

The development of all-digital sensors, the increasing volume of data they produce, its heterogeneity and the enhanced possibility of sharing all this information have brought unresolved needs and questions regarding their use and impact in decision. Traditional online warehousing techniques (OLAP) must therefore be revised: the architecture must adapt to the distributed aspect of data. Acquisition, cleaning and integration should be able to deal with the data streams produced by the sensors. Modelling, querying and analysis must be extended to complex data and could be improved by taking into account a priori models and additional knowledge. Finally, the nature and increasing volume of data motivate new performance evaluation techniques.

This French-speaking conference on Data Warehousing and On-line Analysis has the following aim: to create a context in which researchers, industrials and users interested in the breakthroughs in this field may meet, think and discuss. Following the first edition (EDA 05) a French-speaking community is emerging. This second edition intends to perpetuate and strengthen the community, by discussing new topics, their scientific aspects and novel applications.

Therefore, we would like to extend a call for papers to the researchers and the experts of this field, so that they may present their work. In particular, we encourage Ph.D. students concerned by these questions to participate in this conference, in order to make themselves known. We also invite software editors to participate, in order to demonstrate their new products.

The articles selected by the program committee will be published in a special edition of the RNTI journal, published by Cépaduès Editions.
